Senior Competition Bylaws

As At 6 December 2010

1. Affiliation and team nomination fees are to be decided by the Management Committee and presented as a recommendation to the General Committee for approval.
2. No person under suspension or disqualification shall be eligible to hold any position or office of the Management Committee.
3. No District League Body can arrange any game during the season without the written approval of the Management Committee.
4. The football year shall commence on the 1st of January each year.
5. The undermentioned conditions governing tours to other centres by Junior and Minor League Clubs of the Canberra District Junior Rugby League have been laid down by this League. These conditions must be rigidly observed, otherwise permission to tour will be withheld in the case of future applications by the offending Clubs:
 - (a) All applications seeking permission to visit other centres must be made to the CDJRL in writing no later than 7 days prior to the weekend on which the visit is applied for;
 - (b) A bond of one thousand dollars (\$1,00.00) must be lodged with each application if remaining out of the area overnight;
 - (c) A written report must be submitted to the League covering the tour, immediately the Club returns to the area;
 - (d) References covering conduct must be presented to the CDJRL from the Hotel/Motel or boarding house proprietors with whom the party was accommodated whilst on the tour. These references are to be attached to the tour report, so that all documents relating to the tour will reach the League simultaneously;
 - (e) When teams travel to other centres for one day visits which do not involve overnight accommodation they are required to submit a reference in relation to their conduct from the Secretary of the Club which they visited, in lieu of the references referred to in sub clause (d).
6. A Judiciary Committee will meet at the Queanbeyan Leagues Club, on Tuesday or Wednesday evening at 7:00pm for Canberra Region Junior Rugby League players.
